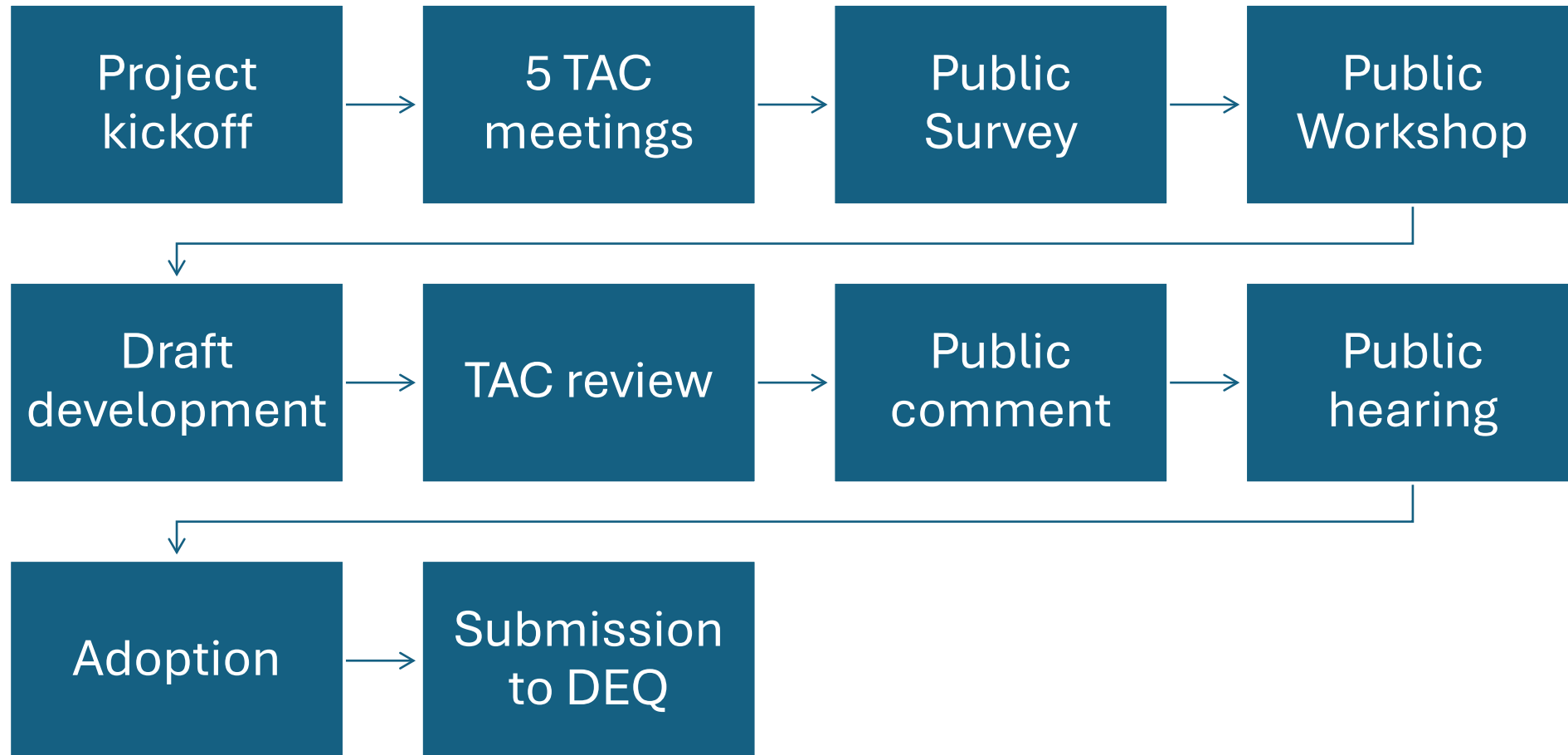

Plan Development Process



SWMP Regulatory Requirements

- VA Regulatory Requirement to update SWMP
 - Adopt new 20-year plan by October 2026
- SWMP Requirements - outlined in 9VAC-130-120 & 9VAC-130-125
 - Basic Planning Elements
 - Objectives for the 20-yr planning period
 - Discuss plan implementation and tracking
 - Facility names, capacity, and lifespan
 - Provision strategy for necessary funds and resources
 - Public education and information strategy
 - Consider public-private partnerships and private sector participation in execution
 - Maintain a 25% recycling rate

SWMP Regulatory Requirements

- Data and analyses
 - Population and projections
 - Urban concentrations, geographic conditions, economic growth and development, reuse and recycling markets, transportation conditions, and related factors
 - Estimates of solid waste generation from residential, commercial, industrial, construction and other sources
 - Listing of existing and planned solid waste facilities
 - All milestones in implementation of SWMP
 - Solid waste reduction program descriptions
 - Outreach program descriptions
 - Procedures for and results of waste collection evaluation
 - Assessment of current & predicted needs over 20 years
- Board resolution adopting the plan

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Changes from the 2021 Plan

- Updated and expanded recycling analysis
- Discussion of recycling rate reporting limitations
- New implementation framework and objectives
- Included plan maintenance and amendment procedures
- Updated and expanded documentation of public engagement
