

Call for Proposals: Housing Summit 2025

From Crisis to Solution: Innovative Approaches to Affordable Housing

The 2025 Regional Housing Summit is set to convene leading thinkers, policymakers, for-profit developers, non-profit developers, and citizen advocates to address one of the most pressing issues of our time: the need for affordable housing.

We are accepting proposals for presentations, workshops, and panel discussions that offer innovative, practical, and scalable solutions to this need.

Summit Details:

- March 2025
- Location: Charlottesville, Virginia
- Theme: Showcasing and Imagining Solutions to the Housing Crisis in our Region
- Session Length: 50-60 minutes

Proposal Submission Guidelines

We invite proposals that align with the summit's theme and focus on one or more of the following areas:

- **Policy and Comprehensive Planning:** Effective policies and planning measures that can drive access to housing, while protecting the rural or cultural quality of the existing community, and preventing displacement.
- **Financial or Institutional Models**: Innovative financing mechanisms, including public-private partnerships, and engaging for-profit affordable housing developers, to fund housing projects. Community Land Trusts and Land Banks are also important topics.
- **Case Studies**: Successful government structures, for-profit projects, and other housing initiatives that can serve as models for the Charlottesville region.
- **Design and Construction**: Sustainable and cost-effective design and construction techniques that reduce the cost of building affordable housing. Enhancing energy efficiency is also an important topic.
- **Rural Focus**: Identifying ways to make housing work in rural areas with special considerations, such as transportation, preserving the rural feel, and providing for infrastructural needs.
- **Equity and Inclusion**: Ensuring that affordable housing solutions are inclusive and equitable for all populations, including marginalized groups, people with disabilities, aging populations, and blue collar workers. Topics might include: Preventing displacement, Workforce housing, Lived experiences, etc.
- **Solutions to Eviction and Homelessness**: Topics might include: Housing first, Permanent supportive housing, Wrap-around services, Landlord mitigation funds, Voucher programs, etc.

Submission Instructions

Please use the following format to submit your proposal.

Proposal Title:

Clearly and concisely convey the focus of your presentation.

Abstract:

A summary (around 300 words) outlining the key points of your proposal, including objectives, methodology, and potential impact.

Session Format:

Indicate preferred session format:

Presentation, Workshop, Panel Discussion, or Other (please specify).

Detailed Proposal:

A detailed description (up to 700 words) including:

- <u>Introduction</u>: Background and significance of the issue being addressed.
- Objectives: Specific goals of the presentation/workshop.
- Solutions Proposed / Presented: Approach and methods used to address the issue.
- <u>Major Take-aways</u>: What will the audience take away as a benefit from the presentation? Consider all of the following attendees: Citizens, Elected Officials, Planning Staff, For-Profit Housing Developers, Realtors, Researchers, Non-Profit Housing Staff, Homelessness Service Providers.
- Relevance: How the proposal aligns with the summit theme and areas of focus.

A brief bio (up to 150 words) for each presenter.

Audiovisual Requirements:

Specify any technical needs for your presentation.
