Charlottesville Area Transit (CAT) passengers will continue to ride fare-free until June 30, 2026 in the City of Charlottesville and portions of urban Albemarle County. All CAT buses are accessible to persons with disabilities and are wheelchair liftequipped.

## Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Paratransit Services

ADA Complementary Paratransit Service is available to individuals with disabilities who cannot otherwise access CAT's fixed-route service. ADA Paratransit is a shared ride; advance reservation, origin-to-destination service provided by JAUNT on behalf of CAT. Passengers may use the service to travel to destinations within a $3 / 4$ mileradius of CAT's fixed-route service. ADA applications may be picked up at the Downtown Transit Station on Tuesdays \& Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Flexible, affordable, comfortable and convenient. Reservations required 24-hours in advance. JAUNT has temporarily eliminated fares.

## Regional Connections - Powered by Jaunt

Jaunt provides curb-to-curb demand-response service in the counties of Buckingham, Fluvanna, Louisa, Nelson and rural Albemarle. Provides ADA paratransit service in the City of Charlottesville and urban Albemarle. Pre-approval by a Charlottesville Area Transit (CAT) representative is required to use Jaunt's ADA paratransit service.
